You are hereby notified that:

1. Any party is entitled to a lawyer in all proceedings in Juvenile Court. If a party cannot afford a lawyer and meets certain requirements, the Court will appoint one upon request. If you wish to have a lawyer but believe you cannot afford one, call the Juvenile Court Clerk at (937) 382-2391, Monday through Friday, from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
2. An order granting legal custody will vest in the custodian the right to have physical care and control of the children and to determine where and with whom the children shall live, and the right and duty to protect, train, and discipline the children and to provide the children with food, shelter, education, and medical care, all subject to any residual parental rights, privileges, and responsibilities. An individual granted legal custody shall exercise the rights and responsibilities personally unless otherwise authorized by any section of the Revised Code or by the Court.
