

You are hereby notified that:

1. Any party is entitled to a lawyer in all proceedings in Juvenile Court. If a party cannot afford a lawyer and meets certain requirements, the Court will appoint one upon request. If you wish to have lawyer but believe you cannot afford one, call the Juvenile Court Clerk at (937) 382-2391, Monday through Friday, from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
2. An order granting permanent custody will vest in Clinton County Children Services all parental rights, duties, and obligations, including the right to consent to adoption, and divests you of any and all parental rights, privileges, and obligations, including the privilege of reasonable visitation, the right to consent to adoption, the privilege to determine the child's religious affiliation, the right to inherit from the child and the right of the child to inherit from the parent, and the responsibility for support.
